

Lions Pride: Club Banner Recognition Awards Patches

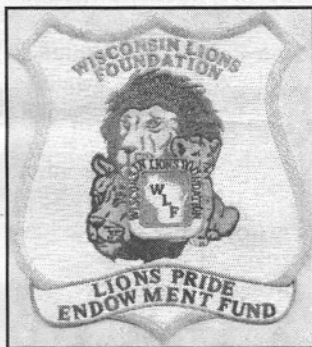

The rounded rectangle emblem recognizes clubs whose donation of \$500 or more makes them Pride Campaign Members. The shield emblem recognizes those clubs that have completed their commitment of \$15,000 to endow a Camper in perpetuity (those clubs will be receiving both patches).
